Teacher's Guide

- **Objective:** Help students identify and describe different types of relationships (peer, adult, authority) and the roles people play in them.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - Read each sentence aloud for auditory learners, pausing for students to supply the missing word verbally.
 - Offer picture cues or role examples (e.g., photo of a teacher, friend, or boss) for visual learners.
 - For higher-level students, ask them to **add their own example sentence** using each word from the bank.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Play a **"Who Am I?"** game where students guess the relationship type from clues you give aloud.
 - Create short skits where students act out the correct way to speak to a peer, a mentor, or a supervisor.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Have students draw a "relationship web" connecting themselves to different people in their lives, labeling each as peer, adult, or authority.
 - Encourage discussion about how communication and respect look different in each type of relationship.
