### Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tips:**

  - Offer **visual aids** (pictures of a friend, teacher, or principal) for students who learn best with imagery.
  - For advanced learners, encourage them to **add their own respectful phrase** to each sentence.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
  - Practice each completed sentence aloud using the right **tone of voice and body language**.
  - Turn the worksheet into a "**Respectful Talk Game**" where students act out the sentences.
- **Extension Activities:**
  - Have students write one new sentence for each relationship type using words not in the word bank.
  - Discuss how using polite language helps build trust and respect in all kinds of relationships.
