The Case of the Missing Question

ChatGPT has produced an answer... but the *prompt* that caused it has mysteriously vanished! Your job? **Think like an AI investigator.** You'll study the evidence (ChatGPT's response), use clues hidden in the text, and reconstruct the *most likely prompt* that could have created it.

Being a great "prompt detective" means paying attention to tone, detail, purpose, and structure. Remember: ChatGPT always responds to what it's *asked* - so the better you can imagine that question, the sharper your prompting skills become.

Directions - Read the ChatGPT response carefully - every word is a clue. Ask yourself: What was ChatGPT *trying to do* here? Who might have asked for this kind of response? What style, tone, or purpose does this suggest? Write what you believe the **original prompt** was. Then, rewrite it to make it even **clearer, more specific, or more creative**.

Exhibit A: The Mysterious Response - "Staying organized in school doesn't mean being perfect - it means creating a routine that fits *you*. Try starting small: keep a daily checklist, use color-coded folders, and take 5 minutes each evening to reset your backpack. Over time, those tiny habits will make big changes."
