4. Explain your reasoning.

Sample Explanation:

This improved prompt would likely produce a more focused and relatable answer. By naming the audience and tone, it prevents ChatGPT from being too formal or generic. Adding a role ("school success coach") gives the AI a voice and perspective, making the response feel more personal and motivating.
