Teacher's Guide

- Review the four nations and highlight bolded names before beginning.
- Read the list aloud and pause to discuss unfamiliar features or traditions.
- Encourage students to reference maps, notes, or previous lessons.

Differentiation Tips

- Provide a short fact sheet summarizing each nation for students who need extra support.
- Allow advanced learners to write one additional characteristic for each nation.

Engagement Ideas

- Display images of the Giant's Causeway, Snowdonia, the white cliffs of Dover, and the Highlands.
- Play short clips of bagpipe music or Welsh choir singing for cultural context.
- Let students work in pairs to debate tricky items before choosing an answer.

Extension Activities

- Have students create a mini poster comparing two of the nations.
- Assign a short research paragraph explaining one cultural tradition from any nation.
- Invite students to design a travel brochure featuring one nation's geography and cultural highlights.
