Teacher's Guide

- Review each attraction and ask students what they may already know about it.

Differentiation Tips

- Provide a labeled U.S. map showing famous attractions for students who need support.
- Offer short verbal clues, such as "This state has a major city called San Francisco."
- Challenge advanced learners to name one additional attraction in each state.

Engagement Ideas

- Have students vote on which attraction they would most like to visit and explain why.
- Create a quick class display called Places to Explore where students add drawings or facts about each site.

Extension Activity

- Ask students to research one attraction and write two interesting facts about it.
