Variant vowel words found in the passage:

- au: none
- aw: boardwalk
- **oo**: cool
- ew: Drew, view
- oi: noisy
- **oy**: joy
- ou: cousin, shout, out
- ow: crow, brown, low, slow, below

Teacher's Guide

- Encourage students to read aloud to hear the vowel patterns more clearly.
 Variant vowels often make similar sounds, so listening helps reinforce accuracy.
- Provide color coding. For example, assign one color to the ow pattern and another to the ou pattern to support visual learners.
- For students who need support, reduce the number of patterns they hunt for. Begin with four, then add more once they feel confident.
- For an extension activity, challenge students to write three new sentences that include at least one word from each vowel pattern.
