

Vowel Team Roll Reader Answer Key

This activity is fluency based. Students should be able to correctly read:

- All ai, ea, oa, ee, and ie words in each list.
- List 6 includes review words using the target vowel teams.

Teacher's Guide

- **Skill Focus:** Builds fluency and decoding through repeated reading of vowel-team patterns. Students gain confidence recognizing ai, ea, oa, ee, and ie in isolation.
- **How to Use:**
 - Model reading one full row before students begin.
 - Students can practice independently or in pairs, taking turns rolling and reading.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - For students needing extra support, highlight the vowel teams in each word before reading.
 - For advanced readers, have them create three new words for any list after they read it.
 - Allow students to read the lists in silly voices to make practice less intimidating.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Turn this into a partner game where one student rolls and the other checks accuracy.
 - Let students color a small box next to each list once they have read it three times.
 - Have students pick their favorite vowel-team list and write a short sentence using two of the words.
