Teacher's Guide

- **Skill Focus:** Students strengthen pattern recognition by identifying vowel-team words that do not belong in a group. This builds accuracy and decoding flexibility.
- **How to Teach:**
 - Review the five target vowel teams before beginning.
 - Model one example by saying each word aloud and listening for matching vowel sounds and spellings.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - Provide color-coded vowel-team cards for students who need visual support.
 - Give advanced students blank lines to create their own odd-one-out rows.
 - Let struggling readers sort words first, then attempt the activity.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Turn each row into a mini mystery and have students explain why the odd word does not belong.
 - Let partners quiz each other by covering one word and having the other identify the missing vowel-team pattern.
 - Add a writing extension where students write a sentence using two matching words from any row.
