Severe Weather Survival Blueprint Answer Key

Note: Answers will vary, but here are examples for each storm type.

Hurricane Example

- **Before:** Board up windows, stock up on food/water, secure outdoor items.
- **During:** Stay indoors away from windows, listen to weather updates, avoid using candles if power goes out (fire hazard).
- After: Check for flooding before going outside, avoid downed power lines, boil water if needed.
