Cause and Effect Chart (Example Answers)

Human Activity (Cause)	Climate Impact (Effect)
Burning coal for electricity	Increases CO2 emissions, leading to global warming
Deforestation in rainforests	Reduces carbon absorption, increases atmospheric CO ₂
Large-scale livestock farming	Releases methane, contributing to heat- trapping gases
Driving gasoline-powered cars	Emits CO ₂ , increasing the greenhouse effect
Increased industrial manufacturing	Produces greenhouse gases and other pollutants
Overuse of single-use plastics	Increases waste and pollution, harming ecosystems
Draining wetlands for development	Reduces natural carbon storage and flood control
Air travel expansion	Produces high levels of CO ₂ per passenger mile
