Cause	Effect
Storm surge pushed into low-lying city areas	Flooding of neighborhoods and infrastructure
Levees broke in multiple locations	Massive flooding that trapped residents
Communication systems failed during the disaster	Slower emergency response and rescue coordination
Hurricane warnings issued	Thousands of residents were evacuated to shelters
Strong hurricane winds and flooding	Wetland habitats were destroyed
