Teacher's Guide

- **Skill Focus:** Deepens mastery of *who* (subject pronoun) and *whom* (object pronoun) in **multi-clause sentences**, teaching students to identify grammatical roles across dependent and independent clauses.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - For students who need extra support, have them isolate the clause containing the pronoun and test it with *he/she* (for *who*) or *him/her* (for *whom*).
 - For advanced learners, introduce relative clause analysis - challenge them to diagram one or two sentences to visualize pronoun roles.
- **Engagement Idea:** Turn it into a "Grammar CSI" challenge. Students highlight the "clues" (verbs and prepositions) in each clause to determine if *who* or *whom* fits.
- **Extension Activity:** Have students write two original sentences - one where *who* is the subject of a dependent clause and one where *whom* is the object of a dependent clause - and explain their reasoning.
