### Teacher's Guide

- **Skill Focus:** Sharpens the ability to choose *who* (subject) or *whom* (object) when parts of the sentence are **elliptical** or implied. Encourages inference and clause analysis.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
  - For students needing support, model how to "fill in" the missing words: e.g., "She's the one *who I thought \_\_\_ would arrive first.*"
  - For advanced learners, have them write the full, expanded version of each sentence to clearly show the implied subject or object.
- **Engagement Idea:** Present the sentences as a "grammar mystery," where students uncover the "missing agent" by reconstructing the full clause.
- **Extension Activity:** Challenge students to create three original elliptical sentences where *who* or *whom* could confuse readers, then trade with a partner to solve.
