Teacher's Guide

- **Skill Focus:** Strengthens grammatical analysis by requiring students to justify *who* or *whom* choices through **clause dissection** - identifying subjects, verbs, and objects within complex sentences.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - For struggling learners, provide color-coded models (subject = blue, verb = red, object = green) before independent practice.
 - For advanced learners, include additional challenge sentences with **nested or implied clauses**.
- **Engagement Idea:** Turn it into a "Grammar Surgery" activity where students label each part of the clause on sticky notes and "reconstruct" sentences on a whiteboard.
- **Extension Activity:** Have students create three of their own multi-clause sentences and explain the grammatical logic behind their *who/whom* choices in complete sentences.
