1) Question: What is friendship? Al Answer: B

Why: More formal, abstract, and lists traits like "companionship, mutual trust, and emotional support" in a mechanical way. The human answer (A) feels warmer and more personal.

2) Question: Why do leaves change color in the fall?

Al Answer: B

- **Why:** Uses vague phrasing like "environmental changes" and "chemical adjustments," instead of the clear, direct explanation in A. The human answer names specific pigments in a natural tone.
- 3) Question: Tell a short story about a lost dog.

Al Answer: B

- **Why:** Generic and flat, with little detail ("a lost dog wandered through the city streets"). The human answer (A) feels specific and emotional, with a dog named Max and a concrete scene.
- 4) Question: What makes someone a hero?

Al Answer: B

• **Why:** Formal and idealized, full of abstract traits ("bravery, selflessness, resilience, determination"). The human answer (A) is grounded in everyday life, highlighting small acts of courage.

Reflection (Sample Responses)

- 1. **Clues:** Overly formal tone, vague generalizations, or lack of personal detail often give away AI writing.
- 2. **Difficulty:** Some Al answers sound polished, so it can be tricky to tell but small details often reveal the difference.
- 3. **Smarter use:** By noticing differences, we can double-check AI outputs and not mistake them for human thinking or lived experience.
