Case 1 - Original Prompt: "Write about a jaguar."

Al Output: "The Jaguar is a popular car in Europe."

- **Problem:** Al confused "jaguar" the animal with "Jaguar" the car brand.
- **Rewrite Prompt:** "Write about the jaguar, the large wild cat found in the Americas."

Case 2 - Original Prompt: "Who is the president?" Al Output: "The president is Barack Obama."

- **Problem:** The question was too vague "president" of which country, and at what time? All also used outdated info.
- **Rewrite Prompt:** "Who is the current president of the United States in 2025?"

Case 3 - Original Prompt: "Tell me about a bat."

Al Output: "A bat is used to hit a baseball."

- **Problem:** Al picked the sports meaning instead of the animal.
- **Rewrite Prompt:** "Tell me about a bat, the flying mammal that is active at night."

Case 4 - Original Prompt: "Summarize the story of Cinderella." Al Output: "Cinderella loses her crown at midnight."

- Problem: Al gave the wrong detail she loses a slipper, not a crown.
- **Rewrite Prompt:** "Summarize the fairy tale Cinderella, including the part where she loses her glass slipper at midnight."

Reflection (sample answers)

- 1. Vague prompts confuse AI because words can have multiple meanings, and the AI has no way to know which one you meant without details.
- 2. Case 2 probably made the biggest difference because specifying "United States" and "current" removes confusion.
- 3. Clear prompts help us get better, more accurate results when using Al for homework, projects, or creative work.
