Teacher's Guide

- **Purpose:** This worksheet strengthens students' **historical comprehension** by connecting major World War I battles with their **geographic locations, tactics, and outcomes**.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - For emerging learners, provide a **map of Europe** to help visualize where each battle occurred.
 - For advanced learners, encourage them to **explain why each battle was significant** in one sentence.
 - Use guiding vocabulary such as *casualties, strategy, front, and resistance* to support comprehension.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Create a "Battle Timeline" on the classroom wall, letting students place cards in chronological order.
 - Have students write a short "battle report" from the perspective of a soldier or nurse at one of the battles.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Ask students to research how these battles influenced later warfare tactics.
 - Compare the **Battle of the Somme** and **Battle of Verdun** to show the devastating effects of trench warfare on both sides.
