___ Germany invades Belgium, causing Britain to declare war.

___ The sinking of the Lusitania turns public opinion against Germany.

___ The Battle of Verdun becomes one of the longest and bloodiest fights of the war.

___ The United States enters the war on the side of the Allies.

___ Russia withdraws from the war after the Bolshevik Revolution.

___ The Armistice is signed, ending the fighting on the Western Front.

___ The Treaty of Versailles is signed, officially ending World War I and setting postwar terms.
