### Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tips:**
  - Provide a world map so students can locate each battle as they identify it.

  - For advanced learners, challenge them to add one sentence describing each battle's significance.
- **Engagement Ideas:**

- **Extension Ideas:**
  - Have students research one of the battles and write a short journal entry from a soldier's perspective.
  - Connect this lesson to geography by marking battle locations on a blank map and noting the year each occurred.
