### Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tips:**
  - Provide a short printed timeline for visual learners who need extra support.
  - For struggling readers, highlight time markers (years) in each sentence and discuss their meaning.
  - For advanced students, remove the years and have them rely solely on contextual clues.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
  - Create a "living timeline" where students hold event cards and physically line up in chronological order.
  - Play a quick "before or after" quiz to reinforce sequencing (e.g., "Did Pearl Harbor happen before or after D-Day?").
- **Extension Ideas:**
  - Have students add one additional event they think was significant and explain its impact in one paragraph.
  - Connect this lesson to geography by locating each event's region on a world map.
