## Sample "Trust Factors" students might select:

Accuracy, Transparency, Bias Awareness, Privacy & Safety, Human Oversight, Purpose & Impact, User Control, and Consistency.

Encourage students to include their own additional ideas such as *Accountability, Accessibility, Empathy, or Sustainability* - these can make great discussion points.
