**Fact-based trust**: Data proves the algorithm is more consistent than human judges when predicting reoffending.

**Feeling-based trust:** People feel it's unfair or "too cold" to let math decide a person's future - a response to moral and emotional discomfort.

**Fact-based trust**: The bot uses data to respond appropriately and remember user preferences.

**Feeling-based trust**: Users who feel comforted or creeped out are reacting emotionally - they either enjoy the connection or feel uneasy about a "fake" friendship.
