Character Diary Voice Answer Key

A correct response should include:

- A character name and title of the movie, book, or show.
- Clear character traits that match the source material.
- A recent or memorable event that makes sense for the chosen character.
- A diary entry written entirely in first person, using pronouns such as I, me, my, mine.
- Thoughts, feelings, and reactions that fit the character's personality and storyline.

No specific diary entry is required because student answers will vary based on their chosen character.

Teacher's Guide

- Encourage students to think carefully about **voice**. A diary entry should sound personal, emotional, and reflective.
- Provide a model character choice for students who need support. For example, pick a well-known character and think aloud about how to answer the planning questions.
- Allow students to use character sheets, book covers, or short clips to refresh their memory of the character's personality.
- For differentiation, offer sentence starters such as:
 - Today I felt...
 - I never expected...
 - I am worried about...
- For engagement, let students read part of their diary entries aloud in the character's voice to highlight how point of view influences tone.
- For an extension idea, have students rewrite the same event from a thirdperson narrator to compare how much more distance is created when the narrator is not the character.
