- 1. Weak Prompt: Tell me about shoes.
- a) Write a 3-paragraph article about how basketball shoes are designed to support athletes' movements.

Why? It gives a clear focus (basketball shoes), a format (3 paragraphs), and a purpose (explain design).

- 2. Weak Prompt: Explain cooking.
- c) Write step-by-step directions for making scrambled eggs, as if you're teaching someone who has never cooked before.

Why? It specifies the task, audience, and detail level — much stronger than a vague "explain cooking."

- 3. Weak Prompt: Write a letter.
- b) Write a polite thank-you letter to a teacher who helped you succeed this year, using at least three specific examples.

Why? Clear type of letter, tone, and content expectations (three examples).

- 4. Weak Prompt: Describe a park.
- d) Write a travel brochure paragraph describing Central Park in New York City, highlighting attractions for families, athletes, and tourists.

Why? Specific location, format (brochure paragraph), and audience (travelers).

- 5. Weak Prompt: Teach me about money.
- b) Write a short guide explaining how to make a weekly budget for a teenager, with examples of income and expenses.

Why? Narrow focus (budgeting for teens), gives structure (a guide), and includes examples.

- 6. Weak Prompt: Explain transportation.
- a) Write a comparison of cars, trains, and airplanes, focusing on their speed, cost, and environmental impact.

Why? It defines the scope (three modes of transport), the categories to compare, and purpose (comparison).

- 7. Weak Prompt: Write about video games.
- b) Write a review of your favorite video game, explaining the storyline, graphics, and one thing you would improve.

Why? It provides a clear task (review), criteria (storyline, graphics, improvement), and personal connection.
