Fix the Prompt Instructions Answer Key (Sample Rewrites)

1. Before: Write a thing about animals. Make it about all animals but also only cats. And don't make it too long but at least 5 pages.

After (Sample Rewrite): Write a 2-page informative article about the behaviors and characteristics of house cats, including at least three examples of how they are similar to or different from other animals.

2. Before: Explain history. But not boring. Make it funny but serious at the same time. Include everything important that ever happened.

After (Sample Rewrite): Write a 3-paragraph article about three surprising events from world history, using a light and humorous tone while still giving accurate information.

3. Before: Tell me how to cook food. But no details. And make sure I can follow every step exactly.

After (Sample Rewrite): Write step-by-step instructions for making a simple grilled cheese sandwich, including clear directions that a beginner could follow.

4. Before: Write a paragraph about the ocean. Make it 10 pages long. Use no words that start with "s."

After (Sample Rewrite): Write a 3-paragraph explanation of the Pacific Ocean, focusing on its size, ecosystems, and the problem of plastic pollution.

5. Before: Make a story about a robot. The robot should be scary but funny and not a robot. Write it like a poem, but also like a script for a play.

After (Sample Rewrite): Write a short story (about 500 words) about a robot who tries to be scary but ends up being funny. Use a playful tone, and include dialogue between the robot and a human character.

6. Before: Teach me math. Just everything. But make it short and also very detailed.

After (Sample Rewrite): Explain how to multiply fractions. Write a step-by-step explanation with two worked-out examples that a middle school student could understand.
