Learning to Write Strong AI Prompts
When you talk to an AI, the quality of your prompt (your question or instruction) shapes the answer you receive. A <b>weak prompt</b> is often vague, too broad, or doesn't give enough direction. This usually results in a short, unhelpful, or generic answer. A <b>strong prompt</b> , on the other hand, is clear, specific, and includes enough detail so the AI knows exactly what you want. Strong prompts lead to responses that are more useful, accurate, and well-structured.
How to Strengthen a Prompt
Ask yourself these questions:
1. <b>Topic</b> : What do I want the AI to focus on?
2. Task: What should the AI do-explain, compare, list, write a story, etc.?
3. Format: Do I want an essay, a list, a script, a dialogue, or something else?
4. Audience: Who is this for-kids, teachers, scientists, or the general public?
5. <b>Details:</b> What should be included or avoided?
