Samples of Significantly Stronger Prompts

1. Weak Prompt: Tell me about cats.

Strong Prompt: Write a one-page article explaining the differences between house cats and wild cats, using simple examples that a middle schooler could understand.

2. Weak Prompt: Explain technology.

Strong Prompt: Give a 5-paragraph essay explaining how smartphones have changed the way people communicate, including at least three positive effects and two negative effects.

3. Weak Prompt: Write a story.

Strong Prompt: Write a short story (about 500 words) about a robot who accidentally learns how to feel emotions. Use dialogue and include a surprising ending.

4. Weak Prompt: Teach me math.

Strong Prompt: Explain how to add and subtract fractions with different denominators. Use step-by-step instructions and provide two worked-out examples.

5. Weak Prompt: Explain food.

Strong Prompt: Write a 3-paragraph explanation of how food travels through the human digestive system, describing what happens in the mouth, stomach, and intestines.

6. Weak Prompt: Tell me about music.

Strong Prompt: Write a short essay that compares classical music and hip-hop, explaining at least three major differences in instruments, rhythm, and style.
