Teacher's Guide

- This activity helps grades 1-2 distinguish between one-syllable and multi-syllable words while reinforcing recognition of the It blend.
- Model clapping syllables for students who need support. Say the word slowly, clap once for each syllable, then let students try independently.
- Allow students to use manipulatives like counters or chips to mark syllables if clapping is challenging for them.
- For extension, ask students to choose one multi-syllable word and break it
 into its syllable parts on paper, or challenge them to think of another word
 that ends with It and sort it into the correct column.
